Undo-Redo is a community-based design workshop led by five distinguished Malaysian architects which focuses on **five specific themes in urban development**. The workshop aims to inspire a new trend of thought in bottom-up architecture design, one that forms a partnership between architecture, the community, authorities and the developer.

Over a 2-week period, participants will be mentored in teams to re-imagine, to undo and redo the potential design of two plots of public land located in Damansara Jaya.

At the workshop, the participants will explore the architecture dimensions of **identity, social need, connectivity, progressive future and sustainable living**. Each team will focus on one of these themes with their respective architect in relation to the dense urban landscape of Damansara Jaya.

The workshop which runs from the **2<sup>nd</sup> of March until the 13<sup>th</sup> of March**, will take place at **Taylor's lakeside Campus** in Subang Jaya. Work space throughout the workshop is subject to the mentoring architect's preference.

Participants are expected to bear the cost of transport, accommodation and living expenses. There will be no reimbursement from the organizers of the workshop.
